

3.2.4.2.4 Surgical therapy for undescended testes after puberty

The Panel consensus recommends orchidopexy in palpable undescended testes and orchiectomy in post-pubertal boys with an intraabdominal testis and a normal contralateral testis in a scrotal position. For adult recommendations, see the testicular cancer guidelines [137, 138].
